

## Building tomorrow's leaders with Student Conventions

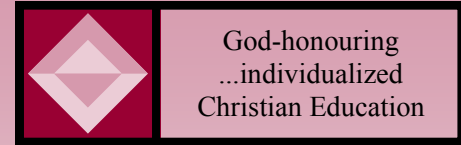
*Lighthouse Christian School works to develop the hidden talents of students, so that they will be better equipped for tomorrow!*

Students may also compete at the International Convention, held in varying locations in the U.S.A.. Student Convention is considered to be an integral part of student training, thus all students are expected to participate.*

**ENROLLMENT AND TESTING FEES** of \$75.00 per student are due and payable in advance of testing and curriculum prescribing. (\$50 for each additional student per family).

**MONTHLY TUITION** of 10 payments  
(12 month payments may be arranged)

1 child enrolled	\$2,500 per year (\$250 monthly)
2nd child	\$4,500 per year (\$450 monthly)
3 or more children	\$750 per year (\$75 monthly)
Kindergarten and Grade 1 (3 days per week)	\$1500 per year (\$150 monthly)
(2 days per week)	\$1000 per year (\$100 monthly)

For larger families with more than 2 students enrolled, we only charge \$750 tuition per year for each additional student (excluding Kindergarten and Grade 1).
